I would like to thank you, the members of the Citizens Financial Advisory Committee (CFAC) for your dedication and hard work in the service of the Town. Having a group of professionals with the financial background and experience to evaluate complex financial issues is a great asset to our Town and Community.

Currently, the Town is in a situation where our cost for water from the City of Troy combined with the operating costs for the Water Department is greater than the amount of money being generated by the current fee structure. In addition to this situation, the Town will begin to repay debt for our upgraded Waste Water Treatment Plant next year. In an attempt to gain information on the options available the Town Board is asking the Citizens Financial Advisory Committee (CFAC) to research and provide an opinion on possible solutions to these financial questions.
