



**WHEREAS**, the Supreme Court, Appellate Division, Third Department, New York ruled in the matter of Theodore W. Ricket v. Town of Colonie that because Public Officers Law 3(1) is a special law, not a general law, municipalities may enact local laws to supersede the residency requirement contained in that statute; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board of the Town of East Greenbush is interested in hiring a Commissioner of Public Works who is not a resident of the Town of East Greenbush; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, that the Town Board of the Town of East Greenbush schedules a public hearing on a new local law providing that the Commissioner of Public Works may reside in Rensselaer, Albany or Washington County for August 17, 2016 at 6:30 p.m. at Town Hall, 225 Columbia Turnpike, Rensselaer, NY 12144; and

**RESOLVED**, that the new Local Law will amend Section 10-6 of the Code of the Town of East Greenbush.
