Resolutions and Proposals by Town Board Members:

60-2008 Refund from General Water District

The Town Board has received a request for a refund in the amount of \$21.23 from the Water and Sewer Billing Department.

61-2008 Resolution authorizing Grant Application

The Town wishes to file an application for funds from the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation for financial assistance to purchase the J. Bove property (Pheasant Hollow and adjoining lands).

62-2008 Resolution authorizing Engineering Services for Water System Improvements

The Supervisor be authorized to recommend the firm to the Rensselaer County Water and Sewer Authority to commence engineering services related to the design of two new 5 million gallon water storage tanks and emergency bypass pumping facilities for the Cross Street water pumping station.
