## **Town of East Greenbush Online Banking Policy**

### **Access Authority**

Access to the internet banking function is restricted to the Comptroller, Purchasing Agent, Director of Finance, Town Clerk and Receiver of Taxes. No other employees or officers will be given access without the express permission of the Board.

All Town Bank Accounts can be accessed via online banking.

### **Internal Transfers**

The following rules apply to intra-bank transfers:

- The Comptroller or Town Board Designee are the only employees authorized to transfer funds between accounts once the transfer is approved.
- Transfers from the Receiver of Taxes or Town Clerk account to the General Fund require the written approval of the respective office holder/account signer before transfers are made.
- Transfers between Town operating accounts must be properly documented and the Supervisor must pre-approve all transfers utilizing the Intra-bank Transfer Request Form (attached).
- Documents supporting the transfer are to be filed by the signing officer and the Comptroller.

### **Wire Transfers**

The following rules apply to wire transfers:

- The Town Comptroller, or Town Board Designee, are the only employees authorized to initiate wire transfers
- Wire Transfers are only authorized from the General Fund. No Wire Transfers are authorized from any other Town bank account.
- No international wire transfers are permitted.
- Wire Transfer Limit is \$1,000,000. No wire transfers above this dollar threshold are permitted.
- Wire Transfers are only to be authorized for debt payments (including Rensselaer County Water and Sewer Authority service payments) or transfers between Town accounts housed at different banking institutions.
- The Supervisor must pre-approve all wire transfers utilizing the Wire Transfer Request Form (attached).

## **Town of East Greenbush Online Banking Policy**

- All wire transfers require a secondary approval step within the on-line banking application. Once initiated, all wire transfers must be approved by the Purchasing Agent or the Director of Finance. The Purchasing Agent or the Director of Finance must receive a completed Wire Transfer Request Form and a copy of the wire transfer initiation. The Purchasing Agent or the Director of Finance shall provide a copy of the on-line approval to be retained and filed with the Comptroller.
- Documents supporting each transfer are to be filed by the Comptroller.

### **Additional Controls**

- The Staff Accountant will ensure that no internet transactions other than those authorized have been carried out and that all documentation is provided to support the transactions that were made.
- The Staff Accountant will review and reconcile the bank statements on a monthly basis to ensure that only authorized transactions have been completed.
- The Staff Accountant does not have access to on-line banking applications.

If any of the above-named authorized users leaves Town employment, the Supervisor is responsible for contacting the banking institutions to remove access to internet banking.

LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF THE YEAR 2013**

**Amending Chapter 22 (Parks), §§22-11 and 22-15 of the East Greenbush Town Code**

**Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of East Greenbush as follows:**

**§22-11. Destruction or disturbance of property and wildlife prohibited.**

- A. No person shall injure, deface, displace, remove, fill in, raze, destroy, disturb, or tamper with any part of the park, including, but not necessarily limited to, any building, fixture, equipment, trees, vegetation, soil, mineral, or any other property appurtenant thereto, whether personal or real, that is owned by the town of East Greenbush.
  
- B. No person shall pursue, disturb, hunt, trap, injure, wound, maim, or kill any bird, reptile, or animal, domestic or wild, within the boundaries of the park unless authorized to do so as a law enforcement officer or as the town's duly appointed, animal-control officer operating in a lawful manner under the explicit direction of the town supervisor; except that non-commercial sport fishing is permitted as provided by law and as limited pursuant to section 22-4 hereof.

**§22-15. Dangerous implements prohibited.**

No person shall carry, use, or have in his possession any explosive(s), firearm(s), air pistols or rifle(s), BB gun, bow and arrow(s), slingshot(s), or any other projectile-firing weapon(s) or dangerous implement(s) within the boundaries of the park unless authorized to do so as a law enforcement officer or as the town's duly appointed, animal-control officer operating in a lawful manner under the explicit direction of the town supervisor.
