98-2013 Police Officer Appointment

WHEREAS, public safety in the Town is a priority concern of this Town Board; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board intends to maintain adequate personnel within the Town Police Department, by appointing qualified individuals to staff the department; and

WHEREAS, the Town Comptroller certifies that the appointment will not have a significant impact on the 2013 finances; and

WHEREAS, Sean M. Markham, has been found to be a competent and qualified candidate for this position; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, that Sean M. Markham is hereby conditionally appointed to the position of police officer of the Town of East Greenbush, effective immediately, subject to the following stipulations:

1. Certification by the Rensselaer County Civil Service Commission;
2. Satisfactory review of the results of pre-employment evaluation, including, but not limited to medical testing, psychological testing and a pre-employment drug test;
3. Final security clearance including FBI background check; and
4. Successful completion of the Zone Five Law Enforcement Training Program; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that said appointment is subject to a probationary period of six (6) months and that said appointee shall establish a principal place of residence, to be located in Town, within one year of this appointment, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon successful compliance with each of said conditions and stipulations that said appointment shall be and hereby is made permanent.
