- 5) Ed Gilbert speaking as Chair confident just with violations in the code doesn't see how any one person would be pointed to. And he stated he is not a fan of taking out the statement it is good the way it was written.

Supervisor Langley stated this was a public hearing on their local law amendments why weren't these questions previously discussed before presenting it to the board for a vote.

- 6) Eileen Grant can pass this amendment it is good work.
- 7) Lee Cookson is in favor of stronger code

Keith asked three times if anyone wished to speak against.
