**Appointment of Angelina Cadena to the Position of

### **83-2013 Appointment of Angelina Cadena to the Position of Town Comptroller**

**WHEREAS**, the position of Town Comptroller was resigned by Jim Breig effective COB March 15, 2013; and

**WHEREAS**, the East Greenbush Town Board (hereinafter, "Board"), in recognizing the importance of one of the key positions in Town Government, has overseen efforts to recruit a replacement for the position of Town Comptroller, including the interviewing of several highly qualified candidates for the subject position; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board, having considered her experience with the Department and the Town, finds Angelina Cadena, a Town resident and Town employee, to be the most suitable candidate for the subject position; and

**WHEREAS**, that this Resolution results in no adverse financial impact to the Town inasmuch as funding for the subject position was provided in the 2013 Annual Budget; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, that, effective beginning of business May 23, 2013, Angelina Cadena be, and the same hereby is, appointed to the position of Town Comptroller at a salary of \$50,000.00; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the Director of Finance shall take all the necessary steps to process the personnel transaction authorized in this resolution

Prior to the vote Councilperson Mangold read the following: "I firmly believe that in going through the interview process that Pete Stenson was the most qualified person for the Comptroller position. I have a lot of respect for Angelina Cadena, her work performance as purchasing agent has been outstanding. I appreciate Angelina for stepping up and performing some of the Comptroller's duties in the absence of a comptroller. Pete Stenson has an MBA in Finance and a long career in governmental accounting. Pete has been working diligently and providing much needed analysis in his duties as Chairman for our Citizens Fiscal Advisory Committee. Pete has proven to have excellent analytical skills and worked very closely with our former Comptroller in budgeting and variance analysis. Pete is also very well versed in the problems we are facing with the UHY Audit and annual audits, he would be a tremendous asset in resolving those issues. With all due respect to Angelina I will be voting no on this resolution." Councilwoman Sue Mangold.

Councilperson Matters welcomed and congratulated Angelina and stated that her experience raised her above other applicants. She has unique qualities, temperament and objectivity due to this she is a cut above the rest.
