

**TOWN OF EAST GREENBUSH  
RESOLUTION 48-2013**

**SCHEDULING OF A PUBLIC HEARING RELATIVE TO PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 22 OF THE  
TOWN CODE (PARKS)**

WHEREAS, the East Greenbush Town Board (referred to hereinafter as "Town Board") has determined that it is in the interest of the town's residents to amend relevant sections of the chapter 22 of the East Greenbush town code to provide for the explicit prohibition of hunting and/or trapping within a town park (referred to hereinafter as the "Amendments"); and

WHEREAS, the Town Board, after due consideration of the proposed Amendments, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, deems the scheduling of a public hearing appropriate at this time in order for the public to review and comment on the proposed Amendments; and

WHEREAS, the Town Comptroller has heretofore attested that none of the provisions of this resolution shall pose an adverse impact to the Town's finances; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that, pursuant to Municipal Home Rule Law § 20, subd. 5, a public hearing regarding the proposed Amendments be, and the same hereby is, scheduled to be held on April 17, 2013 at 6:30 p.m. at the East Greenbush Town Hall; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk shall cause notice of such hearing to be published in the town-designated newspaper, and in the manner prescribed to meet the statutory requirement thereof.
